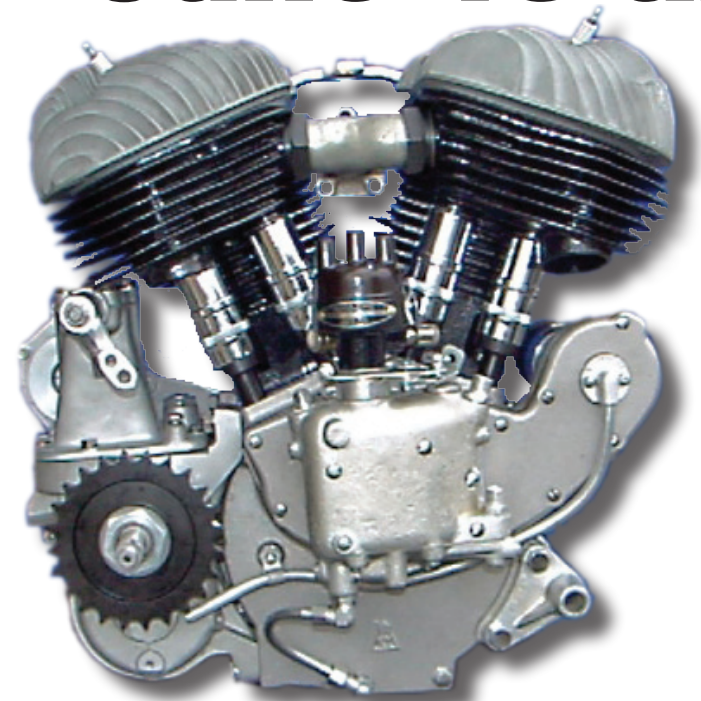

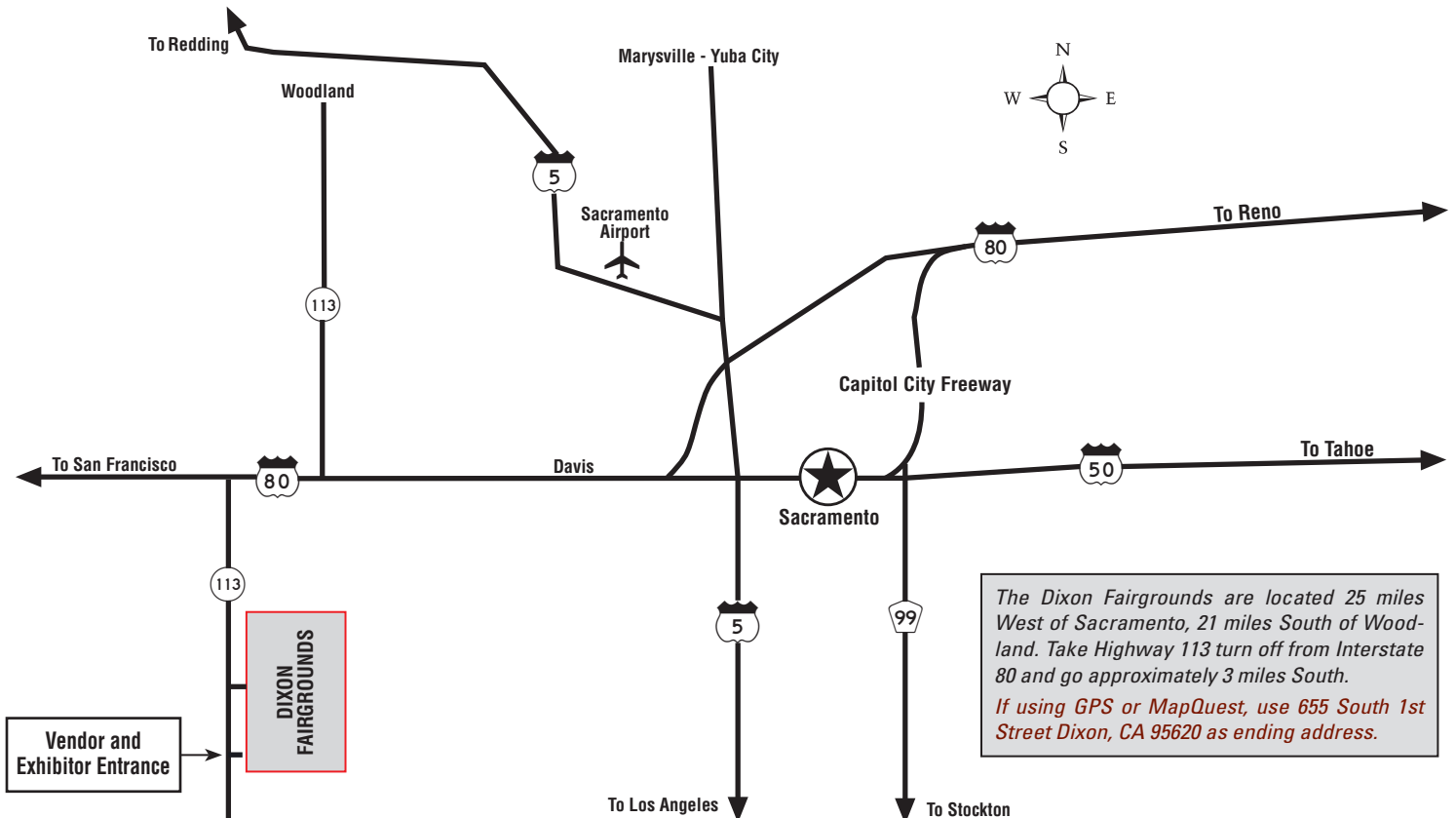

— IMPORTANT NOTES FOR 2012 —

If you have attended our meet before but weren't with us last few years, please note the following changes:

- ◆ If you register for national judging at the meet, the cut off time is **10:00 a.m. Saturday morning**. There will be a \$20.00 fee.
- ◆ The vendor and exhibitor entrance has been relocated to the main gate at the SOUTH end of the fairgrounds.
- ◆ By popular demand, the traditional Saturday night banquet has been changed to FRIDAY EVENING. The awards for national judging will be presented Saturday afternoon as soon as the judging has been completed.
- ◆ Again this year we are offering a "Bike Corral." AMCA members may place a bike (or bikes) for sale in the corral for \$20.00 per machine for both days of the meet. Note: This is only for motorcycles 35 years old or older. No parts, or tools, etc. will be allowed.
- ◆ The fair grounds no longer allows the use of stakes in the ground. We advise bringing weights to anchor your tents, tarps, etc.
